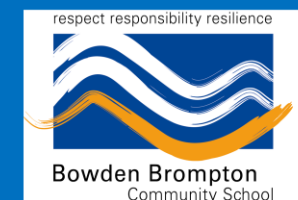

Vocational Pathways program aimed
for students in years 10 - 13 at school
(or 14-18 years) who are disengaged,
or at serious risk of disengaging from
education



ABOUT BBCS GATEWAYS

Gateways is an intervention strategy for students in years 10 to 13 at school (or 14-18 years) who are disengaged, or at serious risk of disengaging from education.

This intensive program offers a small and focussed learning environment (max 14 students) that will nurture and support students to overcome personal, emotional and social barriers and provide opportunities for students to experience individual and educational success.

Each student will be case managed and through guidance and counselling, teachers and youth workers will help learners choose the right pathway. Relationships between staff and students, as well as among students, are characterized by genuine and mutual respect, trust and care. Gateways will help those young people who are struggling with the path they have chosen, to decide how to move forward.

In partnership with Duke of Ed and programs linked to VET, Gateways will have a curriculum that is purposeful, relevant, enjoyable and individualized. Students may be on a negotiated, part-time timetable and may also be engaged in certificate courses, short courses, programs, extra study lines, work experience or work. BBCS Gateways will offer flexible education and training where young people can adapt their learning pathway to suit their interests and abilities.

Through a variety of interactive educational activities, students will increase their Literacy, Numeracy and Social Capabilities whilst working towards Australian Curriculum, SACE and Vocational Education outcomes.



WHERE AND WHEN

Gateways is a full-time (Monday - Friday) program located at:

Gateways students receive a weekly food shop to assist with providing them with a nutritious morning tea and lunch each day to support our health and wellbeing outcomes.

Gateways is an Annexe of Bowden Brompton Community School and students participating in Gateways are required to enrol at Bowden Brompton Community School for the duration of the program.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

Students wanting to participate in BBCS Gateways will be required to:

- Meet the student selection criteria
- Have your school complete a Potential Student Application Form
- Be approved by the Selection Panel
- Participate in pre-entry enrolment session
- Enrol at Bowden Brompton Community School

Students eligible for enrolment in BBCS Gateways are:

- Aged 14-18 years or will be in year 10 to 13 of school for the year of their enrolment in Gateways
- Resident of the Northern or North-Eastern Suburbs
- Disengaged or at serious risk of disengaging from education
- Failing or at risk of failing to successful transition to secondary education
- Students in care (Guardianship Of the Minister)
- Involved with Dept. of Child Protection
- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander (ATSI)
- Averaging minimum of 70% attendance over the past 12 months

Students will **NOT** be eligible for Gateways if they are:

- Currently under exclusion
- Chronic non-attenders (less than 70% over last 12 months)
