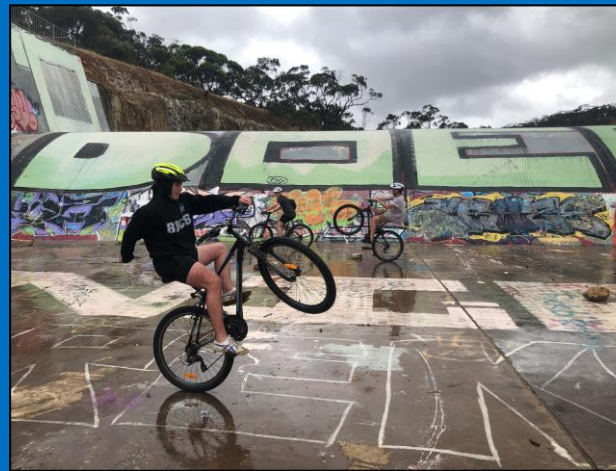

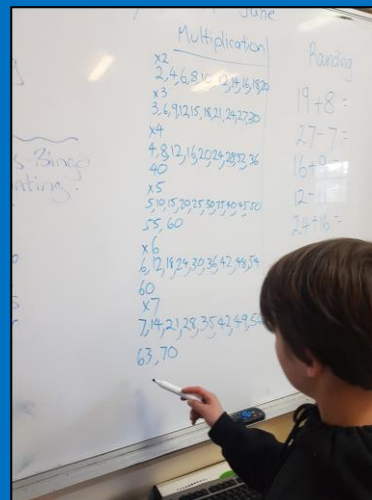
Information sessions and tours of the school are conducted annually in Term 4.

ABOUT INTEGRATE

Integrate is an early intervention strategy for students in years 7, 8 or 9 at school (or 12-15 years) who are disengaged, or at serious risk of disengaging from education.

This intensive program offers a small and focussed learning environment (max 10 students) that will nurture and support students to overcome personal, emotional and social barriers and provide opportunities for students to experience individual and educational success.

Lessons take place in the classroom, within the community, industry and further education institutions to build student connections and offer real life, applied learning experiences. Through a variety of interactive educational activities, students will increase their Literacy, Numeracy and Personal & Social Capabilities whilst working towards Australian Curriculum, SACE and Vocational Education outcomes.

Key features of Integrate include:

- Physical and Emotional Wellbeing
- Personal and Educational Resilience
- Positive Personal and Community Connections
- Vocational and Employment Exposure
- Opportunities to Succeed

Integrate aims to increase students' engagement and responsibility for their learning journey. A range of youth voice, decision making and learning choice strategies will be used to help students set realistic learning and personal goals. Teaching staff and support workers will work together with each student to achieve these goals through personalised learning and development plans.



WHERE AND WHEN

Integrate is a full-time (Monday - Friday) program located at:

Beafield Education Centre (BEC)
90 Beafield Rd, Para Hills West

Integrate students receive a weekly food shop to assist with providing them a nutritious breakfast and lunch each day to support our health and wellbeing outcomes.

Students will meet each day at the City of Salisbury's **Twelve25: Youth enterprise Centre** and be transported by bus to BEC for their learning program. At the end of the day students will be returned to Twelve25 for collection.

Integrate is an Annexe of Bowden Brompton Community School and is run in conjunction with support from BEC. Students participating in Integrate are required to enrol at Bowden Brompton Community School for the duration of the program.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

Students wanting to participate in Integrate will be required to:

- Meet the student selection criteria
- Have your school complete a Potential Student Application Form
- Be approved by the Selection Panel
- Participate in pre-entry enrolment session
- Enrol at Bowden Brompton Community School

Students eligible for enrolment in Integrate are:

- Aged 12-15 years or will be in year 7, 8 or 9 of school for the year of their enrolment in Integrate
- Resident of the Northern or North-Eastern Suburbs
- Disengaged or at serious risk of disengaging from education
- Failing or at risk of failing to successful transition to secondary education
- Students in care (Guardianship Of the Minister)
- Involved with Dept. of Child Protection
- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander (ATSI)
- Averaging minimum of 70% attendance over the past 12 months

Students will **NOT** be eligible for Integrate if they are:

- Currently under exclusion
- Chronic non-attenders (less than 70% over last 12 months)
- Verified with a learning disability
- Eligible for Special Options
